Our Lord Jesus Christ wanted/wants so badly to Remain with us in a Very Real Presence-to Help us through the perils and trials of this life—that He Gave His Priests, beginning with the Apostles, the Divine Power to "Consecrate" or "Change" mere wheat flour & water, plus wine & water, into Himself: Body, Blood, Soul and Divinity! Today's Celebration is meant to help us to appreciate this Awesome Fact and Demonstration of His Love for us! Those who don't believe in this Divine Gift-Presence can easily feel lost and alone.
